

TOWN OF ADDISON RECYCLING PROGRAM

SINGLE STREAM

All items can be placed into one container.

In the Town of Addison the acceptable container is a transparent plastic bag with a maximum capacity of 30 gallons.

Acceptable items for single stream recycling include:

Cardboard	Paper	Newspaper	Food Boxes	Mail	Beverage Cans	Food Cans
Jugs	Jars (glass & plastic)		Plastic bottles #1 thru #7			Glass bottles

Food waste and residue needs to be removed.

ALL OF THE ABOVE ITEMS CAN BE PLACED IN THE SAME CLEAR PLASTIC BAG WITH A MAXIMUM CAPACITY OF 30 GALLONS.

ALL CONTAINERS ARE TO BE RINSED CLEAN.

Large cardboard should be cut into 2'x3' pieces and can be bundled or tied.

Items that CANNOT be recycled single stream include:

Paint, pesticides, automotive fluids, diesel fuel, gasoline, kerosene & car batteries

Recycling pick-up is every other Tuesday. Have recycling at the curb by 6:45 a.m.
