*Monday's & Wednesday's in December & January - from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
(Closed December 24th, 25th, & 31st and January 1st)*

Make check, money order, or bank check payable to **TOWN OF ADDISON**. **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.** A return envelope is enclosed for your convenience in mailing your payment. Payments may also be deposited in the mail slot at the Town Hall, located under the second window to the right of the main doors.

There will be a \$30.00 fee charged for any check returned for insufficient funds.

ESCROW PAYMENTS: Be sure to sign your escrow check if it is made payable to you **AND** the Town of Addison. **Checks MUST BE ENDORSED by the owner(s) before mailing to the Treasurer.** If the escrow check is greater than the amount of the bill, a refund check will be mailed within seven (7) days. Refunds of \$2.00 or less will not be refunded unless specifically requested.

DOG LICENSES

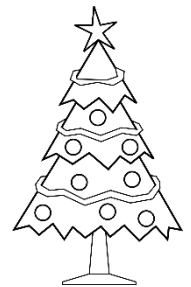


All dogs over five (5) months of age require licensing by April 1st. An application must be filled out completely for each dog. Proof of rabies vaccination and expiration date is required at the time of licensing. No licenses will be mailed without a self-addressed, stamped return envelope.

There is a \$5.00 late fee, per dog, if not licensed by April 1st

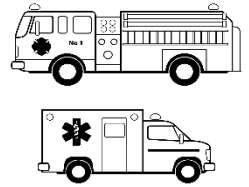
RECYCLING NEWS

SANITARY DISTRICT NOTES: PROPER USE OF SEWER SYSTEM

The sewer system was designed and built for the purpose of conveying water and human waste to the treatment plant. Sinks, toilets and sewer drains are sometimes viewed as an auxiliary wastebasket - an easy place to dump all kinds of things and make them disappear with the pull of a handle. Unfortunately, many of the items that often end up in the toilet, even products labeled "flushable" or "biodegradable", can cause significant clogging problems not only in your home's wastewater plumbing, but also for your community's sewer system and in the Allenton Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF).

There are two things that can be safely flushed down the toilet: human waste and toilet paper. Any other item has the potential to clog up the system. Below is a list of common items that are often flushed that should not be:

- Wet Wipes (Baby Wipes, Disinfecting Wipes, Flushable Wipes)
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Grease
- Paper toweling
- Facial Tissues
- Condoms
- Rags
- Pharmaceuticals and Prescription Drugs

Often, these items do not even make it past the lateral connection from your home to your local sewer system, building up and clogging the line. If these products make it to the street, they can still plug up and damage the pipes and pumps that convey sewage to the WWTF, potentially causing overflows and basement backups that can be costly to repair. If those products do make it to the WWTF, they can also plug up equipment there. Fats, oils, and grease from cooking should NEVER be dumped directly down the drain. Running hot water while dumping the grease does not prevent plugging of the lines. Pour grease and oils into a container and dispose of it in the garbage. Pharmaceuticals and prescription drugs should never be flushed down the toilet or thrown in the garbage. When put down the drain, drugs and pharmaceuticals can get right back into our drinking water supply and be harmful to fish and other wildlife. Wastewater treatment facilities are not designed to remove these contaminants. To help protect the investment we have all made in our homes, the municipal sanitary sewer system, and the Allenton Sanitary District WWTF, please dispose of all disposable wipes, personal hygiene products, grease, and anything else that is not toilet paper or human waste in the garbage, not the toilet.
